\$20.00 late fee will be charged if not pre-registered—post marked by October 15 , 2008
100 milers — \$135.00
75 milers — \$135.00
50 milers — \$ 80.00
25 milers — \$ 80.00

JUNIORS: Must wear helmets, be at least 8 years old and accompanied by an adult sponsor.
*All juniors ride free **The \$15.00 non-member fee applies to these junior riders.*

Members must show a current AERC card

25 mile horses must be 48 months old

50, 75, and 100 mile horses must be 60 months old

NEGATIVE COGGINS MUST BE SHOWN AT CHECK IN

All horses must be presented for a pre-ride veterinary inspection on Friday, October 24 , 2008

Facilities: **No camping before Thursday, October 23, after 11:00**

Primitive camping, no electricity, water for horses only-- water will be on site after Friday 1:00, plenty of camping area, easy access

Dogs must be on a leash at all times!!! NO EXCEPTIONS

NO FIRES IN CAMP

All garbage must be removed, manure and hay spread before you leave

Cigarette Butts must be put in the garbage

This is an environmentally protected area. We must leave it like we found it in its natural state. Camping or tying horses to trees is strictly forbidden. If we keep breaking these rules we will lose this wonderful place to ride. Please follow ride managements instructions on where to camp. Also, ride management is just as tired as you are, please pick up behind yourself around the main tent. Cups, candy paper, plates, etc. should be put in the provided garbage cans. Thank you for your cooperation.

Awards: Awards ceremony for the 25/50 riders approximately 7:00 Saturday night.

75/100 milers will be Sunday morning at 8:30 Sunday morning.

Best condition, top ten, first Junior and a trophy for the first completion in each ride. Everyone who gets a successful completion on the ride receives a completion T-Shirt

Trails: 1800 acres of beautiful fox hunting trails, wooded and sandy. We have some areas that have deep sand but they are very short in distance. Most of the trails have good footing. Some streams and ponds on trail for drinking. Water barrels in "dry" spots. **Please do not sponge out of the barrels. This is for horse drinking water only.** We have two ten mile loops and two 15 mile loops. All loop back to camp with no away vet checks. We hang 400 Glow sticks for night riders.

Meal: We will have our traditional bar-be-cue dinner on Saturday around 5 p.m. until 6 p.m. Bar-be-cue, baked beans, cole slaw and numerous desserts. This is included in your ride entry. Anyone desiring an extra meal ticket can purchase extras for \$10.00 each.

Directions:

I-20 from Florence take exit 98 for Camden– Hwy 521 North. Proceed all the way through Camden going to wards Kershaw. After leaving Camden (you will pass The Tack Room on your right) proceed on down about a mile and you will start to see a blinking light. (you will start to see AERC signs) Go one more mile and turn right on Peckwoods Road. (dirt road)

I-20 from Columbia take exit 92 in Lugoff /Hwy 601 North. Proceed through Lugoff crossing Wateree River Bridge and Walmart will be on your left. Turn left at that light on Springdale Drive. Continue on Springdale passing the race track , a red light and a caution light. Turn left at the caution light on to Hwy. 521, go 1.1. miles and you will be turning on to Peckwoods Road (dirt road). Follow signs.

Highway 521 from Kershaw, pass the EMT facility just before Camden you will go 1.4 miles and turn left on Peckwoods Road (dirt road). Follow signs.
