RELEASE OF LIABILITY

As a participant in the Red Barn Run endurance ride, I agree to abide by the rules of the AERC, SERA, and the ride management of the Red Barn Run. I understand that endurance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time far from communications, transportation and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, and unpredictable; and that accidents can happen to anyone at anytime. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding. I will hold the ride management, all ride personnel, and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses blameless for any accident, injury or loss that might occur due to my participation in the ride, and free from all liability for such injury or loss. I have read and understand this liability release.

CAMPING FACILITIES

Base camp is primitive camping among the pines with water available. Port-o-lets will be provided. Camp will be open on Thursday at noon. Swimming is allowed at your own risk so bring your swimsuits for a dip in the lake or fishing poles for catch and release.

MEALS:

Meals will be provided to riders Friday night and Saturday night at no additional cost and \$6.00 per person for non-riders per night.

AWARDS:

Completion awards will be given to all who successfully complete their ride. There will also be awards for best condition, top ten, and junior riders for both distances.

RULES:

Horse, pony or mule must be 5 years old to enter the 50-mile event; 4 years old to enter the 25-mile event.

All riders must be at least 8 years old and if under 16, accompanied by a designated adult sponsor (21 years or older) for the duration of the ride. Approved safety helmets are required for junior riders.

All AERC and SERA rules apply. Decisions of the vets are final. You have a maximum of 6 hours to complete a 25-mile event; a maximum of 12 hours for 50-mile event. In order to receive a completion for the ride, horses must be "Fit to Continue" as determined by the veterinarians. You must present a negative Coggins test (less than 1 year old) at registration.

Please spread manure and hay when departing.

NO BELLS PLEASE.

TERRAIN:

Mostly flat, wooded trails with some rolling hills and dirt road. All vet checks will be at base camp.

DIRECTIONS: From Macon take I-16 east to the Dublin/Dexter Exit. Take a right at exit ramp onto Highway 257 toward Dexter. Go approximately 6 miles to Dexter, proceed through Dexter and go approximately 5 miles toward Chester. There will be a gate on the right on 257, Camp Perry. Turn right into open field.

From Savannah take I-16 west to the above Dublin/Dexter Exit, take a left at exit ramp and proceed as above.

From Chester take Highway 257 east approximately 1 mile to Red Barn tract sign on your left and enter at Camp Perry gate.

Note: There is a grocery store in downtown Dexter that is open Saturday and Sunday. Chester also has a minute market one mile away.
